## WHERE ARE THE NEW TIVERTON HIGH SCHOOL PLACES?

In June, Petroc filed a planning application for 60 new houses on the land behind College View and bordering Bolham Road.

Residential development there is not included on the agreed Local Plan, and was in a location that could compromise the long overdue new High School and Community Theatre planned for adjacent land.

**CIIr Ben Holdman** of Castle Ward has been asking the important questions about local school provisions, road and pedestrian infrastructure, to prevent local services being overstretched. After receiving many objections, including one from CIIr Holdman, the planning application was withdrawn.

Whilst this is a good outcome for the residents of Castle Ward, it highlights the problem we face with new housing but no new additional school places.

## "NO" TO DORMITORY TOWNS FOR EXETER

The risk of unsuitable housing overdevelopment without the provision of new services and infrastructure to support it is an ongoing problem.

Recently Mid Devon Council was forced to abandon the Greater Exeter Strategic Plan (GESP), which could have seen thousands of new houses built across Mid Devon communities with little thought given to local services, forcing residents to travel into Exeter for jobs.

The new Conservative-led Cabinet are still pursuing joint housing plans with neighbouring authorities based on the model left by the failed GESP. This will lead to more speculative planning applications like the one by Petroc and further increase demand for school places. Where is the new school?

# CHANGES AT MID DEVON CABINET

At the end of August the Leader of Mid Devon Council sacked all four Liberal Democrat members from the Cabinet. This was in retaliation for the entire Cabinet voting to withdraw from the failed Greater Exeter Strategic Plan (GESP) which the Leader supported, and the Liberal Democrats putting forward a motion to continue to work towards

the good goals of the plan, whilst abandoning those that would harm Mid Devon communities.

These sackings were a nakedly political action to purge all Liberal Democrats from the Cabinet, which was confirmed by the Leader of the Council in a public meeting on 30th September attended by Cllr Ben Holdman, Cllr Irene Hill and with questions asked by David Wulff.

The four Liberal Democrat members were immediately replaced with Conservative Party members, under terms that were pre-agreed in a private meeting before the vote.

Whilst it is technically lawful for the

Leader to replace the
Cabinet at will, these
circumstances and his
actions bring the need for reform of
the broken governance system at Mid
Devon-a key Liberal Democrat goalstarkly into public view.

At the September meeting a **Vote of No Confidence in the Leader** was called with 13 votes for, 18 against and 5 abstentions. It was disturbing that 50% of the Councillors present were unable to back the Leader.

The new Conservative-controlled Cabinet currently comprises: four Conservative Party, three Independent and one Green Party members
